

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1 The Committee reserves the right of refusing or canceling any entry without giving any reason for doing so
- 2 Any person guilty of improper or insulting behavior at any time towards the Committee or any member thereof, or any official in relation to their duties may be disqualified or suspended for such periods as the Committee thinks fit, or may be expelled from the Association
- 3 In the event of the judge considering exhibits unworthy of a prize, no prize shall be awarded
- 4 Any exhibitor bringing an exhibit to the ground and willfully failing to exhibit it shall be liable to disqualification during the pleasure of the Committee on the recommendation of the Stewards
- 5 No award ribbon other than those awarded at the show shall be placed on any exhibit whilst on the Showground without the consent of the Steward for the section in which it is entered
- 6 The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program or abridge or postpone the gathering in the event of unfavorable weather or from any cause whatever
- 7 The decision of the Committee to be final in each case
- 8 The Association will not be responsible for any accident caused through or by an exhibitor, and will not, under any circumstance, be responsible for the loss or miss delivery of livestock or the exhibit of any kind, or for any damage done thereto
- 9 The Judge shall have the power to disqualify and mark as disqualified any exhibit, which in his/her opinion does not comply with Regulations, and shall enter their reason in the book. In the event of any protest or disqualification being upheld, the next award in order shall take the place
- 10 If any doubt arises, or if any protest is entered against the correctness of the entry the Committee may demand a statutory declaration from the persons lodging the complaint and shall take evidence pro and con regarding the question in dispute. Such or any protest must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 and lodged with the Secretary no later than 3.00pm on the day of the award, which may be forfeited should the Committee deem it frivolous. The decision of the Committee to be final. Any exhibitor having made a false statement or entry shall be subject to all or any of the following penalties:  
Forfeiture of prize, non permission of the exhibit again, expulsion from the Association
- 11 Vehicles containing supplies will be admitted on the ground free up to 10.00am on the morning of the Show, but must leave the ground as soon as unloaded or requested to do so by any of the Stewards or Officials. No horse shall be ridden or driven except in the vehicle reserve unless competing in the show
- 12 All exhibitors of horses, sheep, cattle, dogs and poultry must be bona fide owners at the time of entry, and no two owners shall be allowed to enter an exhibit unless they constitute a bona fide firm. Exhibitors of fruit, vegetables and flowers must have grown same and the makers of jams, jellies, preserved fruits and butter will receive the prize
- 13 Any person, who after entering exhibits especially of stock, shall be unable through unforeseen circumstances to exhibit same, will be expected to give notice to the Secretary of their inability to exhibit at least three days before the Show, to enable the Stewards to make arrangements more complete
- 14 No exhibit (livestock excluded) to be removed before 7.00pm on the evening of the Show. Any person infringing this rule will be liable to be disqualified from exhibiting at any future show, and if the exhibitor has been awarded a prize, such will be liable to forfeiture
- 15 Any person leaving the ground must show wrist band for re-admission or pay for the re-admission
- 16 Absolutely no collectors shall be allowed to operate at the Gulgong Show. Gulgong Show Society reserves the right to operate a raffle
- 17 All stock must be free of vermin or disease or stock shall be removed from the grounds

## **Exhibitor Entries**

You do not need to be a member of the Show Society to become an exhibitor and enter in the show sections. All information, including entry fees and prizes are listed under the section information pages in this booklet. Separate entry forms are to be completed for each section you enter.

Entries will be taken at the Showground Office from Monday prior to show day,

ONLY between the hours of 10.00am - 4.00pm. A maximum of \$20 will be charged for Pavilion entries per exhibitor.

Exhibits to be collected from Pavilion from 7.00pm show day or **SUNDAY** after the show between the hours of 9.00am - 12.00pm. Any unclaimed exhibits may be donated or disposed of unless prior arrangement are made with the secretary's office.

**Prize Money:** No section prize money is paid in addition to sponsorship prize, e.g. if section prize is \$2 1st prize and the exhibit is sponsored \$5 1st prize, the winner does not get the section prize of \$2 and the sponsored prize of \$5, only the sponsor prize of \$5. If no sponsorship the winner would get \$2.

All prize money will be paid at the Secretary's Office on the day of the show. Any unclaimed prize money or sponsorship vouchers may be collected by arrangement with the Treasurer (phone: 0497 742 689 or email [info@gulgongshow.org.au](mailto:info@gulgongshow.org.au)) for one week post show.

All exhibitors and competitors will required a ticket from 123Tix.com to enter the grounds on Saturday, unless they are a member of the show society.

## **GULGONG SHOW HORSE PROGRAMME - SECTION A**

Chief Steward/Ringmaster: Chris Eggleton 0429 341 444

**All entries, camping and stabling will be through Nominate. Nominations will be open for a certain period before the show and will be shut 7 days prior to the show.**

**Please Note: Fireworks display will be on Saturday evening, commencing between 8.30 and 9 pm.**

All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and the ASC of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse sections at Shows, which can be viewed at [www.agshownsw.org.au](http://www.agshownsw.org.au). Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this horse section, The Gulgong Show Society will support any penalty imposed by that committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse sections at other NSW agricultural shows.

The horse committee will take all care in managing the section but all competitors compete at their own risk. Each competitor must, before competing, complete a waiver (under 18s to be completed by a parent or guardian), indemnifying Gulgong Show Society and waiving any claims against the society for any injury sustained or loss/damage to competitors property or damaged caused by competitors/competitors animals whilst on the show ground. These waivers will be part of the nominations process.

**PIC Numbers Must be provided when nominating for the Show. NO PIC, NO COMPETING!**

The Ringmaster/Chief Steward reserve the right to alter the programme, without notice. They also reserve the right to refuse entry to any competitor with assigning any reason.

**District/Local Classes:** Horses and/or riders must have been a resident for at least three months prior to the show within a 50 kilometre radius of the show ground.

**Novice Classes:** A novice is classed as any exhibit that has not won first prize at any show.

**Hacks/Show Hunters:** Exhibits may only compete in one of the classes. I.E Hacks are ineligible in the Show Hunter classes and vice versa.

**Ridden Ponies:** Ponies 12.2 Hands and under may only be ridden by people under the age of 17.

**Stallions:** Stallions must, at all times, while being handled, have a proper and adequate bit in their mouth and are only to be handled by someone 17 years or older.

When stallions are tied/stabled, there needs to adequate supervision. If tied up outside a yard, they must be double tied.

Stallions are only eligible to compete in designated stallion and breed classes.

## **GULGONG SHOW - SECTION A - HORSES**

**Ring Times:** There are no specific times for classes in rings, other than the first class of the day. Competitors are asked to watch their rings and be ready, as once a class has started competitors will not be allowed to join the class without permission from the Chief Steward/Ringmaster.

**Exiting The Ring:** If an exhibit exits the ring prematurely, it may be disqualified. It is up to the discretion of the Steward and Judge of the ring, and also the Ringmaster.

**Horse Measuring:** There will be no official measuring facilities at the show, but if a question of height arises, proof of height may be required, if proof is not provided, a decision will be at the discretion of the Ringmaster/Chief Steward.

**Breed Registration:** Registration Documents for exhibits in breed classes must be produced when requested by a steward or the ringmaster. In breed classes, breed society rules and regulations apply.

**Attire:** Proper attire must be worn for competitions. This includes appropriate footwear when leading/riding.

**Helmets:** All competitors under the age of 18 must wear a helmet when competing (Both in led and ridden classes). All competitors 18 years and over are encouraged to wear a helmet when riding, and must wear a helmet in classes, unless otherwise stated in breed rules.

**Cruelty:** Anybody considered by an official to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground by the ringmaster. No animal will be allowed to compete if, in the opinion of the Ringmaster, it is in poor health or condition.

**Banned Substances:** Substance testing may be carried out the show.

**Judges:** The judge's decision is final. The Judge has the right to withhold any or all prizes if they deem that the exhibits are not worthy of a prize.

No exhibitor or associate will initiate a conversation with a judge on judging day before or during judging, except through the Ringmaster. A Judge may be changed without notice by the Ringmaster.

No Exhibitor will present for judging before a judge with which they have a personal/family relationship, or have conducted horse related business with within the past 12 months.

**Coaching:** Any exhibitor found to be being coached during a class will be eliminated immediately and not allowed to compete for the rest of the show.

## GULGONG SHOW - SECTION A - HORSES

**Proper Conduct:** Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively will be asked to leave the ground immediately, banned from future shows and possibly banned from competing at other show societies events.

**Stain/Make Up:** If any animal presents in front of a judge and is deemed to have excessive make up of visual staining or colouring, the Judge, Steward and/or Ringmaster have the power to eliminate the exhibitor from the class.

**Protests:** A protest/complaint, against any exhibit/exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the ringmaster or chief steward no later than 10 minutes after judging of the class. An exact nature of the complaint/act must be provided to maintain fairness. The Ringmaster may choose to refer the matter to the protests committee which shall comprise the President/Vice President and two other members of the general show committee.

A Protest/complaint or appeal against the Ringmaster's and/or Chief Steward's decision may be lodged, in writing, no later than 9pm on the day of judging. Any such protest/complaint or appeal will be accompanied by a \$50 dollar fee. A matter lodged this way will be dealt with within 24 hours by the protests committee and their decision is final! NB no protest/complaint will be considered if it simply refers to a judging decision!

## **WOOL ARTICLE/GARMENT STATE COMPETITION**



**Competition to be Conducted at Society, Group &  
State Level**

**CLASS: THREE DIFFERENT TYPES OF WOOL ARTICLES AND/  
OR GARMENTS**

### **CONDITIONS:**

1. For the purpose of this competition the following definitions apply: a) Garment: an item that can be worn e.g. dress, jacket, scarf, hat b) Article: a utility item that is not worn but can be used in the home e.g. blanket; with an outfit eg. bag; for amusement eg. toy; as a decoration eg. picture etc. c) Three Different Types: the 3 items in an entry must differ from each other in terms of their construction technique and/or their purpose eg.1 a knitted jumper, blanket and tea cosy OR eg.2 a knitted tea cosy, a crocheted tea cosy or a felted tea cosy OR eg.3 a knitted jumper, a knitted blanket and a crocheted blanket. 2. The whole article and/or garment must be constructed of, and contain a minimum of, 80% SHEEP wool. 3. Exhibits (articles/garments) may be knitted, crocheted, sewn, felted etc and must be hand crafted (use of machine is permitted). 4. A sample of the yarn, fabric or fibre with label must be attached to each item making up the exhibit. If a label is not available such as in the case of a hand spun or felted item, a handwritten label with relevant details and sample will suffice." 5. An exhibit in this competition may consist of the work of one individual or a group of individuals, or an organization. 6. All three article/garments must have been completed within the 12 months prior to the local show and made by the exhibitor/s. 7. An exhibit having won at a local show may be exhibited (the same three article/garments) at the Group Final. The winning exhibit at the Group Final is then eligible to compete in the State Final. 8. An exhibit is only eligible to represent one Society at Group level and one Group at State level. 9. An exhibit (article/garment) that has previously competed at Group level is not eligible to compete again. 10. If this class is not scheduled or attracts no entries at a local show, the Chief Pavilion Steward in consultation with the appropriate Pavilion Section Judges, may select three suitable individual exhibits and, with the exhibitor's permission, enter them in the Group judging as an exhibit representing the particular Society concerned. 11. It is the responsibility of the Group Secretary and winner to co-ordinate the transfer of the winning entry to the ASC Office in Sydney for the State judging. 12. Recommendation: State Final garments are to include a photo of the garment being worn (where possible and applicable).



5. Each exhibit entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
6. An exhibit having won at a Show will compete at a Group Final.
7. An exhibit is only eligible to represent one Society at Group level and one Group at State level
8. If, for any reason, a winner is unable to compete at Group level then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.
9. All work to have been completed in the last twelve (12) months prior to its entry at a local show.
10. An exhibit that has previously competed at Group level is not eligible to compete again.
11. If this class is not scheduled or attracts no entries at a local show, the Chief Pavilion Steward in consultation with the appropriate Pavilion Section Judges, may select a suitable quilt and, with the exhibitor's permission, enter them in the Group judging as an exhibit representing the particular Society concerned.
12. Group Final location and date is to be determined by the Group. It is the responsibility of either the exhibitor or the Show Society to ensure the quilt is delivered on Judging Day and collected in an appropriate time frame after the competition.

1. The Gulgong Show Society Inc (GSS) runs the Spring Gardening Section (SGS) in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in the GSS General Regulations and these Special regulations {collectively The Regulations} Unless expressly stated in The Regulations, if there is any inconsistency between the GSS General Regulations and these Special Regulations, these Special Regulations prevail. Copies of GSS General Regulations are available on our website [www.gulgongshow.org.au](http://www.gulgongshow.org.au)
2. Application for entry is open to all gardens and mailboxes that are either viewable from a public right of way or where permission is granted to the GSS and judges to view garden from the garden owner as advised on the entry form.
3. If permission is granted then all animals must be contained. The judges have the right to disqualify entry in the case of noncompliance.
4. A public right of way is defined as a road or footpath on the boundary of the property
5. The GSS may accept applications for entry at its discretion







250 g (8 oz) chopped raisins  
250 g (8 oz) currants  
125 g (4 oz) chopped mixed peel  
90 g (3oz) chopped red glace cherries  
90 g (3 oz) chopped blanched almonds  
1/3 cup sherry or brandy  
250 g (8 oz) plain flour  
60 g (2 oz) self-raising flour  
1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg  
1/2 teaspoon ground ginger  
1/2 teaspoon ground cloves  
250g (8 oz) butter  
250g (8 oz) soft brown sugar  
½ teaspoon lemon essence OR finely grated lemon rind  
½ teaspoon almond essence  
½ teaspoon vanilla essence  
4 large eggs.



### RECOMMENDED METHOD:

Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with the sherry or brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight. Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon. Place the mixture into a prepared square 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") tin and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 ½ - 4 hours. Allow the cake to cool in the tin. Note: To ensure uniformity and depending upon the size it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces, cherries 4 –6 pieces and almonds crosswise into 3 –4 pieces. The height of the cake should not exceed 5.7cm (57mm )



### ONE BOWL CHOCOLATE BUTTER CAKE RECIPE

#### Ingredients

125g butter	1 teaspoon vanilla essence
3/4 cup caster sugar	1 1/4 cup self-raising flour
2 eggs	Pinch bicarbonate soda
3/4 cup milk	2 tablespoons cocoa—slightly rounded



#### Method

1. Grease and line a 20cm round tin.
2. Place all ingredients into a bowl & beat until the chocolate mixture changes colour & all the ingredients are combined. (A food processor can be used if you prefer.)
3. Pour the mixture into the tin. Bang the tin lightly on the bench to even out the mixture.
4. Cook in a moderate oven for about 1 hour ( this will depend on your oven) until cake is cooked.

**Hint: If your cake cracks on top this is usually a sign your oven temperature is too hot.**

**Hint: The cake will be ready when it springs back when touched in the centre, and the edge of the cake comes away from the tin.**
