All entries, camping and stabling will be through Nominate. Nominations will be open for a certain period before the show and will be shut 7 days prior to the show.

No refunds after event closes unless a medical/vet certificate is provided, in which case full refund minus 5.5% processing fee. If the event is cancelled for whatever reason (i.e. wet weather) refunds will be processed with a 5.5% processing fee being held back by Nominate.

#### Please Note: Fireworks display will be on Saturday evening, commencing between 8.30 and 9 pm.

All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and the ASC of NSW rules for discipline in horse sections at shows, which can be viewed at <u>www.agshownsw.org.au</u> Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this horse section, The Gulgong Show Society will support any penalty imposed by that committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from horse sections at other NSW Agricultural Shows.

The horse committee will take all care in managing the section but all competitors compete at their own risk. Each competitor must, before competing, complete a waiver (under 18s to be competed by a parent or guardian), indemnifying Gulgong Show Society and waiving any claims against the society for any injury sustained or loss/damage to competitors' property or damaged caused by competitors/competitors' animals whilst on the show ground. These waivers will be part of the nominations process.

PIC numbers must be provided when nominating for the Gulgong Show. No PIC or false/ incorrect PIC will result in entries being declined.

The Ringmaster/Chief Steward reserves the right to alter the programme, without notice. They also reserve the right to refuse entry to any competitor without assigning any reason.

**District/Local Classes**: Horses and/or riders must have been a resident for at least three months prior to the show and live within a 50-kilometre radius of the show ground.

**Novice Classes:** A novice is classed as any exhibit that has not won first prize at any show.

**Hacks/Show Hunters:** Exhibits may only compete in one of these classes i.e., Hacks are ineligible in the Show Hunter classes and vice versa.

**Ridden Ponies:** Ponies 12.2 Hands and under may only be ridden by people under the age of 17.

**Stallions:** Stallions must, at all times, while being handled, have a proper and adequate bit in their mouth and are only to be handled by someone 17 years or older. When stallions are tied/stabled, there needs to adequate supervision. If tied up outside a yard, they must be double tied. Stallions are only eligible to compete in designated stallion and breed classes.

**Ring Times:** There are no specific times for classes in rings, other than the first class of the day. Competitors are asked to watch their rings and be ready, as once a class has started competitors will not be allowed to join the class without permission from the Chief Steward/Ringmaster.

**Exiting The Ring:** If an exhibit exits the ring prematurely, they may be disqualified. It is up to the discretion of the Steward and Judge of the ring, and also the Chief Steward/Ringmaster.

### **GULGONG SHOW - SECTION A - HORSES**

**Horse Measuring:** There will be no official measuring facilities at the show, but if a question of height arises, proof of height may be required, if proof is not provided, a decision will be at the discretion of the Ringmaster/Chief Steward.

**Breed Registration:** Registration Documents for exhibits in breed classes must be produced when requested by a steward or the ringmaster. In breed classes, breed society rules and regulations apply.

Attire: Proper attire must be worn for competitions. This includes appropriate footwear when leading/riding.

**Helmets:** All competitors under the age of 18 must wear a helmet when competing (Both in led and ridden classes), also when riding at any time on the showground. All competitors 18 years and over are encouraged to wear a helmet when riding, and must wear a helmet in classes, unless otherwise stated in breed rules.

**Cruelty:** Anybody considered by an official to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground by the Chief Steward/Ringmaster. No animal will be allowed to compete if, in the opinion of the Chief Steward/Ringmaster, it is in poor health or condition.

Banned Substances: Substance testing may be carried out at the show.

**Judges:** The Judge's decision is final. The Judge has the right to withhold any or all prizes if they deem that the exhibits are not worthy of a prize.

No Exhibitor or associate will initiate a conversation with a Judge on judging day before or during judging, except through the Chief Steward/Ringmaster. A Judge may be changed without notice by the Chief Steward/Ringmaster.

No Exhibitor will present for judging before a Judge with which they have a personal/family relationship, or have conducted horse related business with within the past 12 months.

**Coaching:** Any Exhibitor found to be being coached during a class with be eliminated immediately and not allowed to compete for the rest of the show.

**Proper Conduct:** Any Exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively will be asked to leave the ground immediately, banned from future shows and possibly banned from competing at other show societies events.

Stain/Make Up: If any animal presents in front of a Judge and is deemed to have excessive make up of visual staining or colouring, the Judge, Steward and/or Chief Steward/ Ringmaster have the power to eliminate the Exhibitor from the class.

**Protests:** A protest/complaint, against any Exhibit/Exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Chief Steward/Ringmaster no later than 10 minutes after judging of the class. The exact nature of the complaint/act must be provided to maintain fairness. The Chief Steward/ Ringmaster may choose to refer the matter to the protests committee which shall comprise the President/Vice President and two other members of the general show committee.

A protest/complaint or appeal against the Chief Steward/Ringmaster's decision may be lodged, in writing, no later than 9pm on the day of judging. Any such protest/complaint or appeal will be accompanied by a \$50 dollar fee. A matter lodged this way will be dealt with within 24 hours by the protests committee and their decision is final. NB no protest/ complaint will be considered if it simply refers to a judging decision.

- 250g sultanas
- 250 g chopped raisins
- 250 g currants
- 125 g chopped mixed peel
- 90 g chopped red glace cherries
- 90 g hopped blanched almonds
- 1/3 cup sherry or brandy
- 250 g plain flour
- 60 g self-raising flour
- 1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 250g butter
- 250g soft brown sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon lemon essence OR finely grated lemon rind
- 1/2 teaspoon almond essence 1/2 teaspoon vanilla essence
- 4 large eggs.

RECOMMENDED METHOD: Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with the sherry or brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight. Sift together the flours and spices Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after, each addition, then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon. Place the mixture into a prepared **square 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") tin** and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 ½ - 4 hours. Allow the cake to cool in the tin. **Note:** To ensure uniformity and depending upon the size it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces, cherries into 4-6 pieces and almonds crosswise into 3-4 pieces.

Judge Note: The height of the cake should not exceed 5.7cm (57mm)

3/4 cup milk	2 tablespoons cocoa—slightly rounded

#### Method

- 1. Grease and line a 20cm round tin.
- 2. Place all ingredients into a bowl & beat until the chocolate mixture changes colour & all the ingredients are combined. (A food processor can be used if you prefer.)
- 3. Pour the mixture into the tin. Bang the tin lightly on the bench to even out the mixture.
- 4. Cook in a moderate oven for about 1 hour (this will depend on your oven) until cake is cooked.

Hint: If your cake cracks on top this is usually a sign your oven temperature is too hot.

Hint: The cake will be ready when if springs back when touched in the centre, and the edge of the cake comes away from the tin.




